

## **Scholarship Application Eligibility Requirements**

High School Students: You must...

- 1. Be a Clark County, Ohio resident or enrolled in a Clark County, Ohio high school.\*
- 2. Be a high school senior with at least one completed grading period of the senior year.
- 3. Plan to enroll and complete a full-time program (12 or more hours) each quarter or semes-

ter in an accredited institution of higher learning or post-secondary program.

## Current College Students: You must...

1. Be a graduate of a Clark County high school, or a Clark County, Ohio permanent resident.  $^{st}$ 

2. Be currently enrolled as a full-time college student.

3. Plan to continue in a **full-time program** (12 or more hours) each quarter or semester in an accredited institution of higher learning or post-secondary program.

## Non-Traditional Students: You must...

Be a graduate of a Clark County high school, or a Clark County, Ohio permanent resident.\*
Have received a high school diploma or completed the GED.

3. Plan to enroll in a program at an accredited institution of higher learning or post-secondary program.
