Applicants may attend any accredited post-secondary institution of higher education for a 2 or 4-year program. Financial need may be considered. Garth Q. Briggs Scholarship of the Tecumseh Education Foundation (Renewable)	For graduates of Tecumseh High School to pursue any course of study at any post-secondary institution. Preference is given for technical or trade fields. Based on financial need (40%), academic merit (30%), activities and references (30%). Warren G. Elliott Scholarship <i>(Not Renewable)</i>	For graduates of any high school in Clark County to pursue any course of study at any accredited institution of higher education. Robert M. Farish Family Building Trades Education Fund <i>(Not Renewable)</i>	Restricted for the purpose of providing educational and training opportunities in the building trades for residents of Clark County. The upper high school years, as part of a vocational program, career center, or an alternative educational program, will be considered. Post-secondary programs such as technical schools, career centers, apprenticeship programs, or community college programs are qualified as well. Requires a special application from the Foundation.
