
Other Grant Types

61 **Designated Grants** made up \$300,897 of total grants to the community. These grants came from funds that donors have established to benefit a specific organization or purpose.

Agency Funds are endowment funds that have been established by agencies to provide a long-term income source. \$591,951 was distributed from 29 different agency funds.

In addition, **Donor Advised** and **Charitable Checking** funds benefit non-profit organizations across the country. Grants totaling \$816,208 came from these fund types.
