

The Springfield Foundation strengthens the community by providing grants to non-profit organizations on behalf of our donors. Each year, we distribute funds from unrestricted and restricted funds to meet current needs of Clark County.

In addition to the **Discretionary Grants** listed in this brochure, in 2010 the Foundation distributed:

62 **Designated Grants** to the community, totalling \$329,401. These grants came from funds that donors have established to benefit a specific organization or purpose.

\$547,579 from 32 different **Agency Funds**, which are endowment funds that have been established by agencies to provide a long-term income source.

In addition, **Donor Advised** and **Charitable Checking** funds benefitting non-profit organizations across the country were given. Grants totaling \$596,793 came from these fund types.
