### An Evening Full of Philanthropy's Ripple Effect Throughout Our Community

We would like to extend our gratitude to everyone who was a part of and attended our 2025 Annual Reception! The evening was full of examples of all the good in our community, as well as philanthropy's ripple effect throughtout it.

The program was kicked off by our keynote speaker, Mr. Ed Leventhal, along with his guest speakers: Dr. Yamini Teegala, CEO of Rocking Horse Community Health Center, and scholarship recipient, A'Dymond Sammons. Lastly, A'Dymond shared the meaningful impact that scholarships she received from the Foundation had on her college experience. It was inspiring to hear from a donor, grantee, and scholarship recipient, all exemplifying the expansive ripple effects of our philanthropy.

Ramona Henry was the recipient of the 2025 Catalyst of Change award. This award is bestowed upon a nonprofit, individual, or group that through their unwavering dedication, not only creates opportunities, but also serves as an agent of change who inspires action, drives innovation, and champions equity.
