


#### **GETTING STARTED**

### **REGISTER FOR YOUR ACCOUNT**




If this is your first time applying, you'll need to register your account. Click create a new account on the log in screen and select Individual.





#### YOUR ACCOUNT



Once you are logged into your account, you'll see three pages, In Progress, Submitted and Opportunities.



**Opportunities**: The My Opportunities Dashboard shows which applications are available.


- **2026 Common Scholarship Application** Graduating high school seniors and current college students should complete.
- **2026 Non-Traditional Scholarship Application** Non-traditional student is defined as a student who is 25 years old or older and has never attended college. (If you are 25 years old or older and are currently attending college, please complete the Common Application).

#### STARTING AN APPLICATION

To begin, select the appropriate application from your Opportunities dashboard. Click View to see details about the application. Click Apply to start working on the first phase.



The application homepage is where you can find the due date, a summary and a brief description, and the contact for that application. If you need assistance with the application, please reach out to the application contact.

On each page, you can either save a draft or continue and save when you are finished. Drafts will appear in your In-Progress dashboard. Click view to start application where you left off. If you access an application from your Opportunities dashboard and see the message below, it means you either have submitted or have a draft submission of the application that you can finish from your In-Progress dashboard.

You can also reset your password at any time by clicking on the dropdown next to your name on the top right and go to User Settings.





**Submissions**: The Submissions dashboard shows which applications you have in progress and allows you to view your submitted applications.


- In Progress: Click In Progress to continue working on the application
- **Submitted**: Click View to view your submitted application or download the submitted application in PDF by clicking the download button all the way to the right.



You will see the status of your transcript. If you need to change the information, click Edit. You can also resend the email if the counselor did not receive it.




If you are eligible for any scholarships that require additional information, you will receive the above email.



**Advancing to the next phase:** If the next phase is available, it will appear in your In-Progress dashboard. It is called Additional Questions for Select Scholarships. Click View. You will see the screen below. If you answer "Yes", you will be taken to the appropriate screens to answer the additional questions for that scholarship.
