## **Reflecting on 2024:** Philanthropic Milestones and Community Impact

In 2024, the Springfield Foundation achieved significant milestones, opening 26 new funds and receiving over \$5 million in charitable gifts. We distributed over \$769,000 through 443 scholarship awards and approved funding for 106 discretionary grants in our annual competitive cycle.

## Take a look at all we accomplished with our donors, partners, and community throughout 2024!

- Opened 26 new funds comprised of:
  - 7 Scholarship Funds
  - 6 Charitable Checking Accounts
  - 7 Designated Funds
  - 5 Agency Funds
  - 1 Unrestricted Fund
- Received over \$5 million in charitable gifts.
- Distributed over \$5 million in grants.
- Received a record 143 discretionary grant applications and funded 106 fully or partially.
- Distributed over \$1 million in one competitive grant cycle, a first for the Foundation!
- Received 515 scholarship applications and awarded 443 scholarships.
- Distributed over \$769,000 in scholarships.
- Collected over \$55,000 in Partners in Philanthropy campaign.

- Distributed our first of five \$75,000 yearly grants to the Rocking Horse Community Health Center at Springfield High for mental and behavioral health services in celebration of our 75th anniversary. In the first 5 months of operation, there were 1,160 visits to this health clinic and of those visits, 610 were for behavioral health services.
- Co-organized the "Getting the Grant: A Foundational Grant Writing Workshop" alongside Community Health Foundation, United Way of Clark, Champaign, and Madison Counties, Wilson Sheehan Foundation, and the Springfield chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals.
- Board and staff completed over 100 hours of community service with visits to 5 different local organizations.
- Collected over 60 coats and 15 hats during our winter coat drive; all of which were donated to the Springfield City School District for students.

The Springfield Foundation is looking forward to continuing to raise, strengthen, and distribute permanent charitable funds to benefit Clark County in 2025, while continuing to amplify the good in our community in any way we can.
