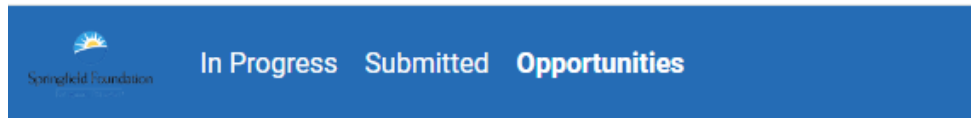

STARTING AN APPLICATION

To begin, select an application from your Opportunities dashboard. Click View to see details about the application. Click Apply to start working on the first phase.

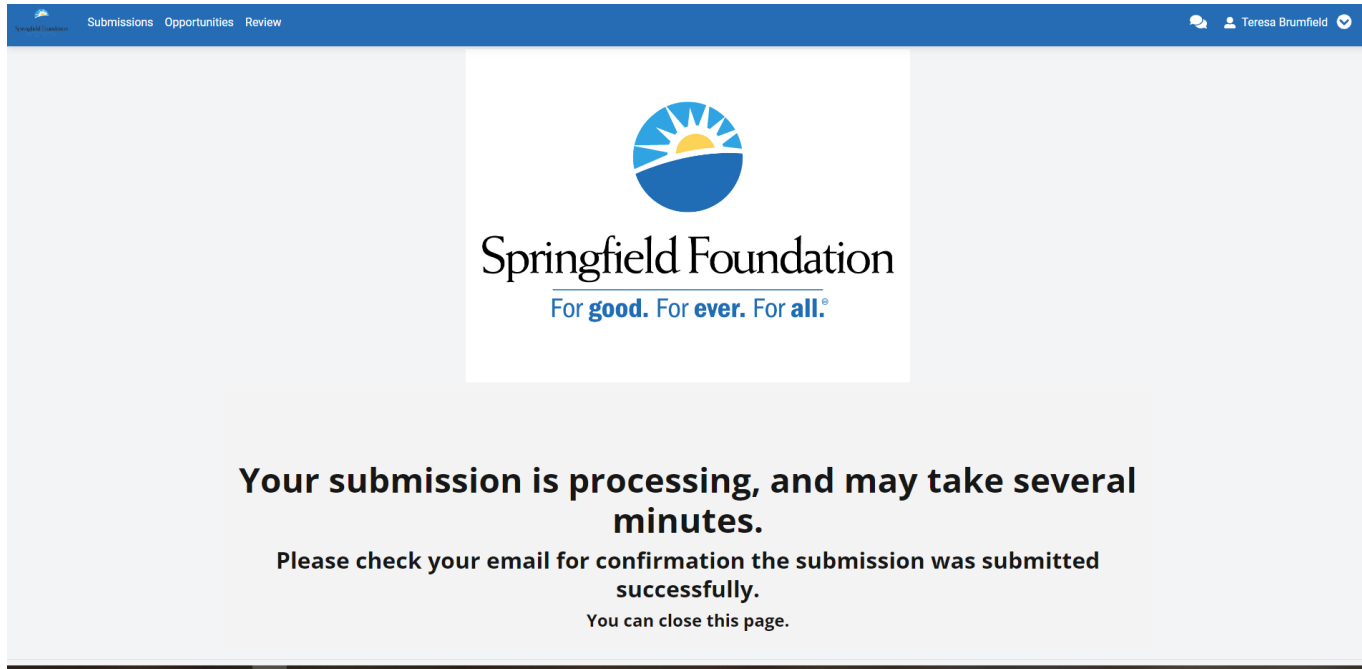
