Anonymous Fund #9 Scholarship (Renewable)	This is a renewable scholarship, for up to 4 years. The first 2 years must be completed at Clark State and if the student chooses to continue to study at a 4-year institution, the scholarship will continue for 2 additional years (or 3 if required for completion of a bachelor's degree). First preference to study in an Agriculture related field.
